| DISCOVER

'a tempo' (usually follows a rit.) means to return to the tempo used at the beginning of the music.

This is a similar rhythmic melody to 'Classical Sequence', but this time with a minor sound (the minor mode). Play very slowly at first - watch all the flats in the second line.
